SEVEN LOCAL CLUBS HOLD FIRST MEET, ELECT OFFICERS

Early last spring, Bill McCloud, Dan Lapins and Ian Harker, all of the Oak Park Ski Club, started the ball rolling by sending out invitations to all of the known recreational ski clubs in the greater Chicago area, The response was immediate and enthusiastic as seven of the most active clubs hastened to join. The Council is currently composed of the following Chicago MedSkis, Oak Park Ski Club, Snow Chase Ski Club, Snow Chase Ski Club, Snow Hawks Ski Club, Snow Hawks Ski Club and the Windy City Ski Club.

The Council elected the following officers to serve for the 1957-1958 season: Harry B. Madsen, president; Libby Faler, secretary; Merle Goedjen, treasurer. 
