

# CHICAGO WEEK 2025 FEBRUARY 22 – MARCH 1 JACKSON HOLE, WY



Bordered by the jagged peaks of the Tetons, Jackson Hole is a valley and wilderness recreation area in western Wyoming. Featuring two mountains, Après Vous and Rendezvous, Jackson Hole Mountain Resort is known for its gorgeous scenery and challenging terrain, including the infamous Corbet's Couloir (pictured on the right), which towers over the rest of the resort and has people testing their wits every winter.



Half of the terrain is rated expert, 40% intermediate, and only 10% beginner. The intermediate terrain is primarily on south-facing Après Vous Mountain, while Rendezvous Mountain has Jackson Hole's more advanced terrain, including bowls, glades, and chutes. At over 4,000 vertical feet of skiing, Jackson Hole boasts one of the greatest continuous inbounds rises in the U.S.
