While there may be plenty of like-minded people out enjoying the slopes, they'll never feel crowded with an average of two people per acre. With 4,406 vertical feet, 3,342 acres of terrain, 98 trails, 20 chairlifts and access to your choice of cruisers, glades, steeps, terrain parks and halfpipes, there's always more to ski and ride at Snowmass!
